She doesn't move.

HALLIE'S DAD (CONT'D) You're fuckin' anorexic! Eat your breakfast!

Hallie slams her spoon down and gets up. Her dad comes after her.

HALLIE'S DAD (CONT'D) Get back here!

He grabs Hallie's arm and shoves her to the floor. She tries to resist and get up. He pulls her to the table and throws her in the chair.

He takes the bacon from his plate and begins to shove it in her mouth.

HALLIE'S DAD (CONT'D) You want me to feed it to you!? How's that!? Huh!?

Hallie cries as she is forced to eat the bacon.

HALLIE'S MOM Look at your father when he speaks to you!

EXT. MARY AND JESSA'S HOUSE - MORNING

MARY and JESSA run through the front yard.

MARY

C'mon! Hurry!

Jessa struggles to keep up. We hear shouting from the house. The door flies open revealing Mary and Jessa's dad, RAYNE.

> RAYNE You little sluts! The fuck are you goin'!?

MARY Jessa, hurry!

The girls escape down the street as Rayne stops at the end of the yard. He spits as his chest heaves up and down. He lights a cigarette and turns back toward the house.

EXT. ROAD SIDE - MORNING

Mary and Jessa walk together. Old buildings and tall grass line the road side.

JESSA (catching her breath) Wait.

MARY C'mon, we gotta go! He might get the truck.

Mary looks behind her. We hear the rumbling of an old pickup truck in the distance.

MARY (CONT'D) Get off the road!

She grabs Jessa's arm and pulls her off the road behind an abandoned building.

EXT. ABANDONED BUILDING - CONTINUOUS

The truck screams by, seconds after.

MARY (CONT'D) If he's had whiskey, there's no tellin' what he'll do.

JESSA What do we do?

MARY We'll go to the tracks. C'mon.

They run from behind the building toward the woods.

EXT. RAILROAD TRACKS - DAY

Cal and Hallie sit on the tracks. Mary and Jessa walk up behind them. Cal and Hallie notice them but say nothing. The four of them sit quietly in a row.

STONE (from behind) 'Sup bitches?

The others turn around to look at him. He sits down at the end of the row. Silence.

Cal scoops a handful of rocks and begins to chuck them into the distance.

CAL Where'd you go?

STONE You miss me?

Cal chuckles. He looks at Hallie.

CAL What's wrong with you?

MARY Leave her alone.

CAL Just askin'.

HALLIE We need to do somethin'.

STONE

We?

HALLIE I can't do it alone.

CAL What are you talkin' about?

Hallie falls silent. Mary puts her arm around Hallie.

MARY

What happened?

No answer.

CAL What do you wanna do? Kill 'em?

Silence.

CAL (CONT'D) Just playin' around. Seriously, what do you wanna do? Hallie gets up and walk a few feet away. She turns back to the group. HALLIE

EXT. LAKE - EARLY MORNING

The jump cuts stop as we rest on the children, overlooking the lake. They disappear one by one until only Hallie is left. She vanishes as...
